



## 2006 European Union budget: selection for NGO projects

Every year, the EU budget is published in the Official Journal. The 2006 budget was adopted on 15 December 2005 with the European Parliament's second reading and published in Official Journal L 78 of 15 March 2006. It amounts € 123,5 billion in commitment appropriations. We have selected, out its more than 1800 pages, the budget lines that are a potential source of funding for the not-for-profit sector. The full text includes a short explanatory note about the use that can be made of each budget line and its legal basis (for example, the reference to the corresponding EU programme).
